Prayers and hope

Prayers continue for the safe return of Madeleine McCann who has been missing for almost two weeks.

New photos have been issued showing the unusual feature in her right eye called a black flash where the pupil colouring runs into the iris. High profile stars and business people have put up large sums of money in excess of two and a half million pounds in an attempt to persuade anyone with information leading to her safe return to come forward.

Portuguese bikers rode the length of the country distributing leaflets showing recent pictures of Maddy. In England, her favourite football team, Everton, played their premiership match wearing shirts with her photo on them. In the UK and Portugal many people including children have tied yellow ribbons around rail-

ings as a symbol of hope that she will be returned to her family safely. In Fátima many pilgrims were seen carrying posters of the child. At a church service in Luz on Saturday, the day Madeleine turned four years old, Gerry McCann said her disappearance had unleashed a "tidal wave" of devastation on the family.

The police continue to interview potential suspects and witnesses and have been supported by three experts from the UK to assist in their search. A number of newspapers in the UK and Portugal have also added to the reward money offered.

In a press conference on Monday morning Gerry McCann told reporters that the couple have set up a fighting fund to sup-

port an ongoing search for their daughter. Donations from the public are being managed with the help of a legal team from the UK to ensure no stone is left unturned in the investigation. McCann said: "Since the lawyers have come here we have visibly felt a burden being lifted from our shoulders." He also thanked the media for the excellent job in keeping the profile of the case so high, and also the staff at the Mark Warner resort. Twelve people have been interviewed including the McCanns and recordings will be kept as video evidence for any future trial. This unusual step has been taken as many of the witnesses reside overseas, primarily in Britain.

Freeport bomb alert

An anonymous bomb threat led to the evacuation of Freeport shopping centre in Alcochete on Sunday. A man had called the Setúbal Public Security Police from a public telephone saying he was going to place two bombs in large shopping centres in the district. The evacuation went smoothly, without panic and the centre reopened to the public at around 6.45 pm when the authorities declared the threat a false alarm. Other shopping centres in the area were also checked but no bomb was found, and it seems that Freeport was the only centre evacuated.

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INTERNATIONAL

UK

Blair steps down

Tony Blair travelled to his Sedgefield constituency to make his announcement to around 250 of his local supporters in the town of Trimdon. The Labour party leader told the audience at the Labour Club of his decision to officially hand in his resignation to the Queen on June 27.

He made a thoughtful and

emotional speech about the last ten years during which Britain has been under his leadership declaring Britain now a leader and not a follower on the world stage. He also considered that expectations were probably too high back in 1997. "Sometimes in decisions you are alone with your own instincts," referring to

September 11 when he decided to stand shoulder-to-shoulder with his ally, as he later chose to do in Afghanistan, Iraq and other situations. On the subject of the Iraq war he acknowledged, "for many it simply isn't worth it," and went on to say, "the blowback from removing Saddam was costly," adding, "I apologise for the times

I have fallen short." Reflecting overall he said: "Hand on heart, I did what I thought was right." Ending on a patriotic note he added that Britain was the best nation in the world. He believes Britain to have changed significantly over the last ten years and is in much better shape for his successor.

Battles against nature

Springtime across America has brought some of the most challenging weather patterns and natural disasters, with flooding in the Midwest, fires around Hollywood and tornadoes in Kansas. A fire that has been burning for three weeks in southern Georgia has so far damaged around 170 square miles of forest and swamp land causing smoke to drift across much of Florida. Last week we reported the tornadoes in Kansas, devastating the town of Greenberg and now flooding has followed with thunderstorms across the flat plains.

In Missouri the aptly named village of Big Lake turned into its namesake, with all but one hardy resident retreating from the flooding that reached roof-level in some homes. In Los Angeles fires caused damage throughout Griffith Park over an area of 800 acres close to the famous Griffith Observatory. There were also wildfires along the Canadian border in northeast Minnesota, destroying homes and businesses in its path. All in all a challenging week for rescue and fire services throughout the country.

Marine accused

Staff Sergeant Frank Wuterich, the marine who led the unit accused of killing 24 Iraqi civilians, is under investigation for the unlawful killing of five men in Haditha as they stood with their hands in the air. It is alleged that he tried to cover up the incident where the five men were shot dead by telling his comrades to lie about what happened, blaming the deaths on the Iraqi army. Three other marines have also been charged with second degree murder. Iraqi witnesses claim Wuterich shot the men in retaliation for a roadside bomb that killed Lance Corporal

Miguel Terrazas when their convoy passed through in November 2005. Sergeant Dela Cruz, also present on the day, testified that Wuterich was distressed about the death of Terrazas known as TJ and after the explosion which ripped Terrazas' body in half he shot dead the five men as they stood next to a car, with their hands raised. He claims to have seen Wuterich shoot the men in the upper body before he himself sprayed the bodies with bullets. The Marine Corps agreed to give Sergeant Dela Cruz immunity from charges in exchange for his testimony in court.

Elections

Current East Timor prime minister José Ramos Horta has won the presidential election by a huge majority of an estimated 73 per cent. The Nobel peace prize winner said: "I'm happy with the results. I will carry out my duties according to the constitution and listen to advice from everybody so that I can take East Timor to a better future." In a statement prior to voting, opposition candidate Francisco Guterres, said the party would respect the results.

Abortion case

A 17 year old girl, pregnant with a baby unable to survive beyond three days, is to be allowed to travel to the UK for an abortion. The teenager, currently in the legal care of the Irish health service, won a high court case in Dublin to be able to travel to Britain and is supported by her estranged mother.

Iraq visit

US Vice President Dick Cheney visited Iraq last week staying overnight at an army camp at Speicher, near Tikrit, a predominantly Sunni province not far from the home town of former leader Saddam Hussein. The area has many supporters of the dead leader. He used the visit to encourage Iraqi leaders to move quickly to reach power-sharing deals in a bid to quash sectarian violence saying: "We are here, above all, because the terrorists who have declared war on America and other free nations have made Iraq the central front in that war."

Olmert survives vote

Israeli Prime Minister Ehud Olmert has survived his third no-confidence vote in parliament following heavy criticism of his handling of the Lebanon war. He is accused of failure to exercise "judgement, responsibility and prudence" during the 34-day war in 2006 and has been subjected to an official enquiry focusing on these areas of concern. Olmert acknowledges the investigation and wants to remain in office in order to put the subsequent findings into practice.

BRAZIL

Abortion debate

On Thursday evening Pope Benedict XVI addressed around 40,000 young adults in the Paceaambu stadium in São Paulo at the beginning of his five day tour of Brazil.

He stressed to the enthusiastic audience the need to respect life "from the moment of conception until natural death". Brazil is currently debating the issue of abortion led predominantly by the health minister who believes the operation should be allowed in certain circumstances. The Catholic Church represents around 64 per cent of the Brazilian population falling by around 1 per cent each year due to the rise in evangelical Christianity. The Pontiff talked of the challenge of convincing Catholics to remain with the faith in the country which houses the largest number of Catholics in the world. In referring to the decision made in Mexico City on abortion, he said that those supporting the law and medical workers who performed abortions would be excommunicated from the church although there was some confusion about this when a Vatican spokesman later said that the Pope would not excommunicate anyone but such people would "exclude themselves from Communion".

AFRICA

Child soldiers to be discharged

The government of Chad has agreed a deal with the United Nations Children's Fund (Unicef) to remove children serving in the national army. Chad formally denied the existence of underage soldiers but due to a high profile campaign by Unicef and an in-

vestigation that found over 300 child soldiers at one single location, they have agreed to take action to resolve the situation. While it is suggested the army did not deliberately sign up children, the recruiters overlooked the question of age if the child

lied. A large number of children were found to be between eight and 11 years old with forged birth certificates. It is also acknowledged that it may be difficult to persuade these minors to leave the army and to return to their communities.

TURKEY

Constitutional amendment

The parliament in Turkey approved an amendment to allow the president to be directly elected by the population appealing to those protesting about the forthcoming elections. The change is said to be a likely cause for

further tensions in the country where the government has been heavily criticised by secular-minded citizens protesting about the possibility that the new government will lean towards the Islamic religion. The reforms, if

passed into law, will mean the new president will be elected for a five year term, renewable for five more years, but many say the amendments have been rushed through and have not been subject to rigorous debate.

FRANCE

Sarkozy sails into storm

The newly-elected president has already been the source of controversy before even taking office. As is the custom in France the newly-elected president is taking a short time to recuperate from the gruelling election process before taking over as leader. Sarkozy has taken time out with his wife Cecila and son Louis to celebrate victory and relax on a luxury yacht around Malta sparking criticism by many socialists and fuelling ongoing protests from those who oppose his leadership. The yacht belongs to French billionaire Vincent Bolloré and is available for hire at €200,000 per week. Mr. Sarkozy told reporters that he was taking two and a half days out to relax on a trip that did not cost the French people one cent, saying: "I do not intend to hide, I do not intend to lie, I do not intend to apologise."

NORTHERN IRELAND

Return of devolution

A ceremony was held last week at Stormont to celebrate the new power-sharing government headed by Martin McGuinness of Sinn Féin and Ian Paisley of the DUP. At midnight on Tuesday 8 May five years of direct rule by London ended and the devolved government took control over decision making. Tony Blair and Bertie Ahern, Irish Prime Minister, attended the historic event. Ian Paisley said Northern Ireland was now "on the road to prosperity". Martin McGuinness said that he is confident they can work together. The only demonstrators at the event were protesting against the war in Iraq. Peter Hain, Northern Ireland secretary, commented on the new beginning as resolving the most "intractable source of political conflict in Europe."

UK

Civil servant prosecuted

David Keogh, 50, a civil servant has been jailed for six months and ordered to pay £5,000 to the prosecution for taking it upon himself to publish details of a private meeting between US President George Bush and Prime Minister Tony Blair. He was convicted of breaching the Official Secrets Act by leaking a memo containing details of a private meeting on Iraq between the two leaders in April 2004. Keogh was employed as a government communications specialist and was responsible for the distribution of the memo to a select group. The recipient of the four page document, Leo O'Connor, 44, was sentenced to three months in jail. O'Connor put the secret memo onto the desk of an unnamed politician, known to be a Labour anti-war supporter, who called the police immediately. The document was marked secret and confidential causing much of the trial to be held behind closed doors. The memo allegedly contained information regarding M16 but the exact contents are unknown. Keogh, who opposed the war in Iraq, maintained the right to leak the information as he was alarmed by the content, suggesting Bush was a "madman", and had felt the need to disclose the information to Parliament.

Women behind trash TV

Sir Patrick Moore has stirred up a hornets' nest by accusing the BBC of reducing the quality of programming over time because it is run by women. The longest-running presenter on TV, appearing in the Sky at Night for 50 years, described female newsreaders as "joke" and suggested the best way forward would be to have different channels for men and women. "I would like to see two independent wavelengths - one controlled by women, and one for us, controlled by men," he said.

Mini-EU summit in Sintra

Durão Barroso, or Manuel Barroso as he now prefers to be called, President of the European Commission, presided over a mini-summit last Saturday in the Portuguese town of Sintra.

Along with Barroso were German Chancellor Angela Merkel as Council President, Hans-Gert Pötering as European Parliament President, and the prime ministers of Portugal and Slovenia, José Sócrates and Janez Jansa as representatives for the next two upcoming EU presidencies. The group reflected on the European Constitution and future challenges for Europe. After the summit a source for the European Commission claimed that the EU Treaty may be finalised by December of this year, whilst the EU is under the presidency of Portugal. The Treaty will substitute the previously presented and rejected Constitution.

Portugal will take over as President of the European Union in July.

Immigration Law

Parliament passed a new immigration law last Thursday which has been subject to much criticism from immigrant associations across the nation.

The Platform for Immigrant Community Representative Structures (PERCIP) demonstrated disapproval of the law claiming: "The expectations of thousands of immigrants and their associations were deceived as the new law does not foresee the regulation of all immigrants who are working and living in Portugal, opening up only a few exceptions which comprise the minority."

Paulo Portas, leader of the CDS-PP told reporters, "The law has positive aspects, but the government made a mistake, in Article 59, introducing weak criteria. People can become immigrants with a declaration of interest from any employer, regardless." It seems that such a loophole would be advantageous for human traffickers, especially if the control of

such immigrants is not upheld.

The new law states that foreigners seeking work in Portugal may be issued temporary residence permits if their qualifications are sufficient to register on the employment exchange. Such immigrants will be required to present a valid employment contract or legitimate offers of employment. A revised visa system for guest workers and the concession of residence permits to researchers and highly qualified foreign employees are also contained in the law. Companies employing illegal immigrants will be subject to large fines and marriages of convenience are considered illegal.

The law was passed by the votes of the PS and PSD with the CDS-PP and BE voting against and the Greens and the PCP abstaining.

Addict support

The Piaget Agency for Development (Apdes) in Porto invited Theo van Dam, renowned for his work in support of drug addicts throughout Europe, to be the patron in their endeavour to create a Portuguese association for the support of drug users.

One of the pioneers of needle exchange programmes, Dutchman van Dam told Lusa: "Human beings must be treated with dignity," deploring the fact that he had found Portuguese drug addicts living in "horrible conditions". Van Dam has helped found over 50 associations all over Europe and presented various simple projects that could be developed in Portugal in order to help drug users, apart from the more common syringe exchange schemes and safe injection sites. The workshops delivered by van Dam were attended by various representatives of the Drug and

Drug Addiction Institute, the National Association of Pharmacies, Joaquim Urbano Hospital, the Matosinhos GNR and Public Security Police and Judicial Police from Porto.

Alina Sousa, spokesperson for Apdes a non-profit organisation, told Lusa that a meeting to organise the foundation of the Association in Defence of Drug Users is to be held on 6 June. "Apdes has two teams working with drug users supplying syringe kits and aluminium foil," Sousa said, adding that the association intended to introduce mobile units to operate in areas where drugs are consumed.

Profitable retirement

The number of retirees receiving monthly pensions over €4.000 grew by 12,3 per cent in 2006 with 378 new public employees receiving the so-called *golden* pension. The majority of people receiving these large retirement benefits are politicians, magistrates, hospital administrators, teachers, diplomats and military personnel.

Eco- adventure

Last weekend saw the first trans-Portugal rally with vehicles powered only by ecological fuels such as vegetable oils or biodiesel. The vehicles departed from Bragança on Saturday and the rally ended in Quarteira on Sunday. The organisers hope to raise the awareness of the general public and the government to the use of alternative fuels.

Fishermen dead

Two fishermen were found dead in their bunks on board the vessel Santa Cristina which was moored at the time in the Galician town of Cangas, to the north of Vigo. It was suspected that both, age 28 and 36, died of an overdose. The bodies were subjected to an autopsy before being returned to their families in the Aveiro district.

Youths saved

Two teenagers were saved from drowning with the help of two students and two gypsy men last week. Apparently the four rescuers managed to pull Jaime Silva and Tiago Araújo, 15 and 16 years old respectively, out of the water where they carried out mouth-to-mouth resuscitation in order to save the boys who were both unconscious. Meanwhile a bar owner had contacted the local bombeiros who arrived on the scene within 20 minutes and continued the resuscitation process. Both boys were taken to hospital but were discharged quite quickly, continuing recovery at home.

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Lisbon council falls

At midnight last Wednesday the executive council in Lisbon was dissolved with all opposition councillors abdicating their positions, as well as 20 of the 26 elected PSD councillors.

Leader of the council, Carmona Rodrigues, refused to resign and was allegedly supported by Fontão de Carvalho, Gabriela Seara (both with suspended terms of office), Pedro Feist, Remédio Pires and Fernando Santana. Last week it was reported that all PSD councillors had agreed to resign after party leader Marques Mendes had requested the same in order to provoke council elections. Although these six councillors did not step down, their solidarity is not enough to prevent the election of a new executive.

The fall of the Lisbon council was to be officially communicated to the Civil Governor's office last Friday after Rodrigues and his team had collated all the necessary documents relating to the matter.

"I was elected by the people of my city and now I leave because of the votes of the [political] parties," Rodrigues claimed,

apologising to the public last Thursday for "not achieving and improving more", adding that he always acted in the name of "responsibility". He would not confirm whether he intended to stand again in the next elections. His right-hand man, currently suspended from his position as deputy Mayor, Fontão de Carvalho, blamed Left Bloc councillor José Sá Fernandes for the collapse of the council saying Fernandes had "contributed in many ways to this conclusion."

By Friday four names were confirmed in the election race. The first to make the announcement was Helena Roseta who is to stand as an independent candidate after resigning as a militant Socialist. Furthermore, Ruben de Carvalho has been confirmed as the Communist/CDU candidate in coalition with the Greens (OV) by party leader Jerónimo de Sousa and also Sá Fernandes for the Left Bloc

(BE). On going to press, no firm decision had been reached by the Socialist Party, but rumours mentioned current minister for the state and interior, António Costa, although party leader and prime minister Sócrates confirmed that this was "pure speculation." Leader of the National Renovation Party (see *get real* editions 12, 13 and 14) José Pinto Coelho will also be standing for the position as council leader in order to fight "corruption". Over the weekend it was reported that Marques Mendes, leader of the PSD, favoured Fernando Seara, head of Sintra council as the party candidate.

The National Election Commission has, as yet, not confirmed dates for the elections but 8 and 15 of July have been suggested and possibly even the first day of July. The Civil Governor is duty bound to hold the elections within 40 to 60 days from the date of dissolution.

Afghanistan action

This week a contingent of the Portuguese army, said to be mostly commandos, are to serve as part of an international force in Kandahar. According to a source at the defence ministry the soldiers will be mainly conducting patrols but the area is known to be classified as high risk. Cavaco Silva confirmed that there were risks involved but was confident about the ability of the soldiers. "The mission in Afghanistan is a risky one but we cannot forget that it is contributing to a peace mission in the region, and we hope to the reduction of world terrorism as well as the fight against drug trafficking," he told reporters, remembering that Portuguese forces were also present in Lebanon and Kosovo, also missions of risk. He concluded: "Portugal is part of the international community that wants peace. The defence of our country today goes beyond our own borders."

Public TV under the eye

Entidade Reguladora para a Comunicação Social (ERC), the regulating body for the media, presented the rules it intends to adopt in relation to party political pluralism within the public television network to the minister for parliamentary affairs last week.

The rules outline an evaluation of news programmes shown on Portuguese public TV stations RTP1, RTP2 and RTP-N which will monitor political representation. The new regulations come on the heels of various complaints by political parties such as the PSD and PCP of discrimination by RTP1 in the programme "Pros e Contras" (For and Against). At present neither SIC nor TVI will be subject to such scrutiny although some political parties feel they should not be excluded for being private.

Thousands flock to Fátima

The largest group ever of faithful pilgrims gathered at the Catholic shrine of Fátima in central Portugal this weekend on the 90th anniversary of the sighting of the Virgin Mary by three young shepherds, all now deceased. Many had travelled on foot from all over Portugal.

Due to the unusually large number of visitors access to the shrine was not easy and before the candle procession at 10 pm on Saturday the director of the Civil Protection called for pilgrims not to force their way in. By mid-afternoon on Saturday there were no more parking spaces in the town and even residents were experiencing difficulty in reaching their homes. After the procession and service pilgrims were delighted with the news that Pope Benedict XVI had announced his intention to visit Fátima within the next few years. Pope John Paul II visited Fátima in 1982 and 1991.

One Spanish pilgrim died, age 80, and many others were treated at campaign hospitals set up in the area during the celebrations.

As can be seen in the background of the picture on the right, some pilgrims approached the shrine on their knees,

Officer shoots ex

Last week on Tuesday a 33 year old GNR officer, Carlos Borges, killed his ex-girlfriend whilst she was in the company of another young man. It seems that the 21 year old victim had given a lift to a school colleague and the officer had followed them to the spot where the shooting occurred, approximately 100 metres from the colleagues home. The first shot fired by Borges personal, legally registered weapon lodged into an electricity post and in the ensuing confusion Borges managed to fire three shots into the victim's neck causing her immediate demise. Afterwards the officer shot himself in the temple and was declared brain dead but continued to show vital signs. Borges had apparently been pursuing the girl since their relationship of three years finished about a month ago.

Negative news

Mariano Gago, minister for science, technology and higher education issued an official despatch to the Independent University (UnI) and to SIDES, the company that manages the institution, which withdraws public interest recognition of the establishment. This declaration, released to Lusa, substantiated the decision on the final report of the Director General of Higher Education which states that it has been "unequivocally proven that the UnI does not retain the minimum legal conditions required to be recognised as an institute of public interest." This decision runs alongside the current process of compulsory closure of the establishment, but recognition of public interest is essential for the UnI to function legally.

In a statement to Lusa the management and faculty declared that they "contest the spirit of the communication," claiming it contained "arguments that, at least, imply a substantial amount of subjectivity." It was further stressed that: "The Independent University is far from closing its doors and classes continue with even more students, as is public knowledge."

Lunar real estate

American businessman, Dennis Hope, was in Portugal last week to promote his enterprise, Lunar Embassy, selling property "with views to the earth".

Hope claims to be the owner of the "only real estate agency legally qualified to sell property in space". The project began in 1980 when Hope filed a declaration of ownership, initially with the land registry in San Francisco, and subsequently with the US and Russian governments and the General Assembly of the United

Nations, laying claim to the moon and other planets. His missives received no reply and today the Lunar Embassy has sold lunar plots to many, including the rich and famous. Property is available from €25 per hectare and the deal is sealed with a Lunar deed.

Allegedly, the business has so far made around €4.4 million all

over the world.

As a warning to the Portuguese, legal advisor for DECO, Luis Salvador Pisco, stressed the fact that: "In legal terms this is a situation in which the people cannot claim they have been subject to fraud as it is all too evident what is going on. I doubt any court would side with the claimant."

Everyone ought to believe in something... I believe I'll go fishing.

A day on the high seas beckoned. I had two friends taking a break from the grey of North Yorkshire and a fishing expedition was suggested. I found myself at the harbour in Portimão handing over a deposit for a Monday expedition of *bottom fishing*. I hadn't fished much since my teenage years but I was sure the old techniques would soon come back...

We found free parking by the Clube Naval in Portimão and boarded our vessel, the Nitucha, a cheery red-painted boat settled on the smooth morning water.

"We have had a cancellation so it's just you three," came a voice from the bridge, straight out of East Enders. "Hey ho, and off we go," we cheered, as I found a seat near the back end which later I was reliably informed was the stern.

Before we passed the harbour walls we were given a full safety drill including the precise location of two inflatable lifeboats that are inspected annually despite never having been used. There is a first aid kit and sensible information is imparted, with special details given when there are children on board. The location of the beer facility was also noted but studiously avoided by the Skipper who, after all, has a boat to run.

Frightening facts

To the strains of some gentle blues music a welcome coffee was produced from the ever-ready kettle and a get-together ensued over the photo album of *Fearsome Sharks and Other Creatures*

Captured, showing stills of first-timers looking shocked alongside their hoisted, silvery prey. The real horror is a picture of a great white shark landed 12 years ago which, at 1.100 kilos, caused a stir. The hapless creature had swum into a net three miles offshore from Portimão sending many seasoned fishermen into spasms on inspection of the landed body. We, however, were *bottom fishing* which I expected to be a rather more relaxed affair.

Perhaps not, as the album also contained severe pictorial warnings as to which fish are poisonous and not to be handled, such as the weaver fish (*peixe aranha*) and the scorpion fish (*rascasso*). As a once only experience the skipper has been punctured by weaver fish spines resulting in his hand swelling to the size of a boxing glove, severe pains in the glands under the arm and, when the swelling subsided with a dousing of household vinegar, the loss of several layers of skin on the affected area.

Fishing grounds

Our gasps of horror at these poisonous sea devils were clearly taken as signs of maritime encouragement and coloured maps

of the seabed were swiftly produced showing our destination, a rocky seabed seven miles off Carvoeiro. Reaching our fishing grounds involved navigating over mud and sandbanks. Each area is used for different types of fishing by the many craft that are licensed to fish commercially. There are the night-time squid boats that are a familiar and somehow romantic site for us landlubbers, the four daily trawlers sweeping all into their huge nets, the small netting boats and the pot boats that catch the octopus, squid and cuttlefish that end up as daily restaurant fare.

The *doca pesca* on the Arade river near Portimão's old iron bridge is the central point for the local fishing industry as all catches must be landed there to be sold and taxes levied on sales. If you are served a fish with a tell-tale harpoon wound you can correctly surmise the fish has evaded all tax and should thus taste all the better.

Fish & fishermen

On the topic of fish, where are all the tuna? They breed in the Mediterranean and then funnel past Gibraltar, swinging south along the coast of north Africa or

north along the Algarve. North or south is determined by the warmth of the current and Africa does win out most years. The other missing fish is the sardine, so linked with Portugal's past image. These have been so over-fished that those left breed far away from danger. Looking back at the Ferragudo shore from our boat we could see several chimneys of the derelict sardine factories soon to be incorporated into another marina. There is one chimney in Parchal in the Lidl carpark, if you want a close look at one, and another at the Boca do Rio hotel at Mexilhoeira de Carregação where the old steam boilers have been preserved in the bar area with the chimney rising up through the roof.

Are there many opportunities to go big game fishing in the waters of the Algarve? Dave Goodison used to run a game fishing boat out of Albufeira but packed up last winter. Bob Pearson at Vila Real de Santo António is still battling with licences after a boat purchase deal went wrong to the extent that he cannot leave the country until it is sorted out. This leaves our skipper of the day, Clayton Davey, running his service from Portimão. Clayton's

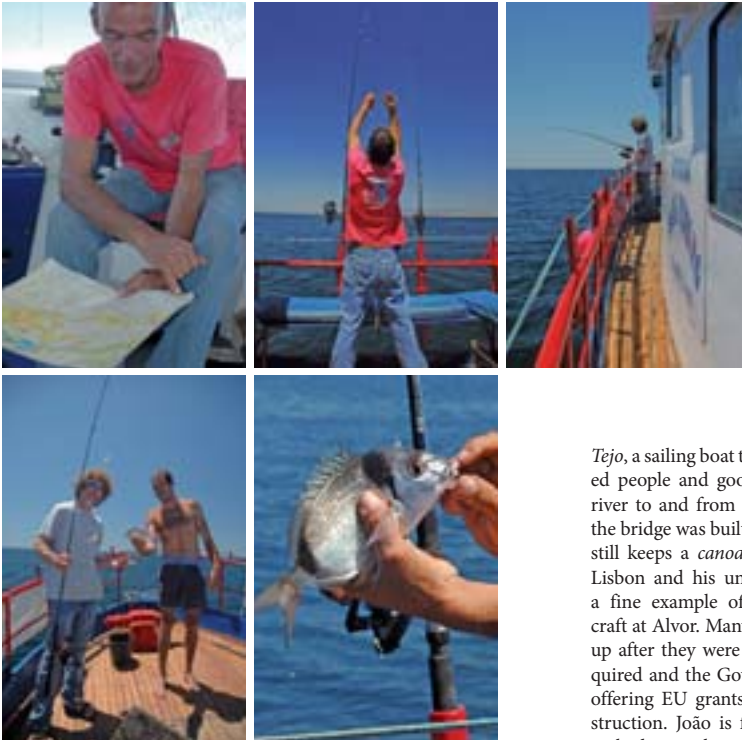
wife, Roz, manages all the bookings and accounts but stays safely on shore.

The shark fishing season is during the summer months and depends for success on the sea temperature rising. The Nitucha goes out daily in the season, and weekends only in the winter months. Night time shark fishing is for the very bold in the summer when the sea temperature reaches 24/25 degrees centigrade.

Two types of fishing tour are on offer. Firstly the big game shark fishing day where most combatants are first timers and a good day can be had by fishermen and women and paying spectators. The second, upon which your intrepid correspondent found himself with two incredulous friends, is the bottom fishing tour which is guaranteed to produce something for everyone, surely?

Seaworthy, not seasick

Clayton bought the boat four years ago from Fred Steel as part of the new skipper's life realignment programme. The Nitucha is a robust 14 metre sea-going cruiser which feels safe and sturdy. It was built in Lisbon to withstand heavy seas and it does not bob around a lot, avoiding the involuntary *mal*

de mer ground-baiting to which many are susceptible. The keel was laid (*good use of old sea-dog terminology! Ed.*) in 1958 and the hull is now stripped and sanded every year, the wooden decks are re-oiled and larger engine maintenance carried out. There is a toilet or *head* (which is useful in personal emergencies).

Fun kit aboard includes the GPS system which shows the location of the craft and the harbour and lots of flags to help steer you about safely. There is a fish-finder gismo indicating when there are fish under the boat and at what depth. All the rods necessary are provided as is ample bait of shrimp and shellfish for our trip.

Life changes

Skipper Clayton Davey hails from south east London and was in the building trade until his mid-life crisis hit at exactly 40. His parents are expert fishers who were champions in 1978 in the UK. When presented with Clayton's change of career, "I am going to be a shark fisherman", the astonishment was total. They can now watch with some pride from their home in Ferragudo as their son chugs out to sea every day. Clayton had onshore fishing

experience, otherwise known as angling, but had certainly never owned a seagoing vessel equipped for a potentially dangerous sport.

Clayton displayed an easy charm to sooth us softies and loves the job that he admits is now a full time obsession. "The hardest thing was going back to school at 40 years old," which is exactly what he had to do to gain his skipper's licence. With plenty of practice on a wealthy friend's boat in the UK, followed by an intensive three week course in Plymouth, Clayton's first step towards his dream was taken. Moving to the Algarve with Roz and youngest son, Clayton spent valuable time shadowing Nitucha's vendor Fred prior to taking command. This helped Clayton familiarise himself with the fishing areas, the boat and the many particular regulations from the Harbour Master and Maritime Police who are tough and seemingly random in their ever-increasing desire to issue fines for long forgotten or freshly-issued regulations.

In good hands

João the deckhand has worked on the Nitucha for two years. His grandfather used to run a *canoa de*

Tejo, a sailing boat that transported people and goods across the river to and from Lisbon before the bridge was built in 1975. João still keeps a *canoa de Tejo* near Lisbon and his uncle maintains a fine example of this historic craft at Alvor. Many were broken up after they were no longer required and the Government was offering EU grants for their destruction. João is from a family with deep sailing roots and his own maritime knowledge is most reassuring.

Wildlife preservation

Clayton explained his hatred of fish: "Can't stand them, I will eat fish fingers and fish cakes as there is precious little fish in them, covered in dressing naturally." This makes him an ideal fish conservationist and the care taken over the catch is endearing. Some of the fish we caught, when hauled to the surface, had disended swim bladders which were pricked to release the air. After recuperation in a handy bucket of sea water, all but one survived and were returned to the sea.

Clayton is part of the international cooperative shark tagging programme run by the US Government's National Marine Fisheries Service. This continuing research into the biology of large Atlantic sharks started in 1960 with just 100 volunteers. The programme has since been extended and now includes 6,500 people distributed along the Atlantic and Gulf coast of North America and Europe. Numbered tags sent to participants are attached to the base of each shark's dorsal fin. An accompanying data card is filled in after tagging, logging the shark's weight, date and location of capture, sex and the size of fishing gear used to catch it. When a tagged shark is re-caught the tag is retrieved and sent on to the US. Between 1962 and 2004 over 188,000 sharks have been tagged and 11,000 have been recaptured. Distances between taggings vary from nil to 3,740 nautical miles. In total three species, the blue shark, shortfin mako and tiger shark travelled over 3,000 nautical miles. The longest period between taggings of the same specimen is just under 28 years. The data provides valuable information on migration and the extent of fish movements including rate, routes, abundance, age and growth.

Sharks tagged on the Nitucha have been re-caught off Tenerife

and the Azores, coastal Spain and west coast Portugal often by the same intrepid long line fisherman, one Jaime Mejuto from A Coruña who has re-caught 23 to date. I suspect he is no longer married.

The Nitucha has also caught a naval shell casing (spent), a foul-smelling dead shark and has witnessed a whale circling the boat and the surfacing of an alarmingly large submarine on exercise, luckily one of ours.

A great day out

Despite my amateur fumbblings we certainly caught our fish supper and sufficient for a fine *cataplana* for João, including horse mackerel, Spanish mackerel, red gurnard, sea bream, black bream, *besugo* and something called *bongo* that was thrown back immediately. We did not catch octopus, cuttlefish, moray eel (thank heavens) cuckoo wrass or *bicas* although these are often hooked.

We spent a total of seven hours on board for €50 a head. I loved it as you not only get to view the Algarve coast from the sea, which is beautiful, but you learn lots about our maritime environment from Clayton and João who, after all, spend a third of their life afloat and have a wealth of experience to impart cheerily.

THE LOWDOWN

...on Burgau.

Jackie Teasdale made the move to Burgau last July, in the peak of the summer, leaving behind a life in the UK. She chose the little western Algarvean village because it is unspoilt and you can still stroll around the streets enjoying the atmosphere without being consumed by tourism. Only a ten minute drive into Lagos, it is in Jackie's opinion, one of the best towns in the Algarve, with everything to hand. According to the sign on the way in, Burgau has 7.000 inhabitants but it is hard to believe they live here all year round.



Why Burgau?

Jackie told us that it reminds her very much of a traditional Cornish fishing village with its painted boats, amazing beach, rambling streets and small cafés. Along the coastline are beautiful cliff-top walks, one taking you all the way to Luz and in the opposite direction you will find the Almadena fort with views over the ocean and you can see Salema in the distance. You can watch the boats going in and out and chill out in a café away from everything and still be in the busy resort of Lagos in a matter of a few minutes. Overall the decision to move here was based on value for money, location and distance from the sea.

Two car parks overlook the

beach and even in peak season it is usually possible to find a space. Because of the steep roads and pathways the one drawback is that it is difficult to manoeuvre prams or wheelchairs around.

Availability of schools

The Vale Verde School is within a few minutes' walk and has been open for around three years now serving the ex-pat community. This is a secondary level school. The Barlavento English School in Espiche is a well-established primary school for children of all nationalities following the UK curriculum. It has an excellent reputation. There are of course Portuguese schools as well for those who

want their children to be fluent in the Portuguese language.

Favourite local beaches

Burgau beach is 700 metres from Jackie's home, one of the deciding factors of purchasing the property. While in the UK Jackie dreamed of living within close proximity of the sea and now it is a reality.

Sport facilities

The Burgau Sports Centre is on the way in to Burgau coming in by the second entrance, at the turn off for Alma Verde. It has squash, tennis, stretch classes and a swimming pool. There is a well established children's club on Saturdays with a great programme of activities for kids,

more extensive in the summer months.

Boa Vista and Parque de Floresta are the two nearest golf courses.

Comparison between high and low season

Even in August it is still quiet and accessible. Parking in the town may be more difficult and the beach busier but apart from that there is no real difference. In winter it can get pretty cold and you need to get your logs delivered early for the fire before the winter rush. It is quiet but there are still people around.

Future plans for the area

More building of villas and apartments.





Shopping facilities

The village has two small supermarkets, a mobile post office (open 10.50 until 11.30 week-days), a wine shop, artisan and gift shops. There is also a cash machine.

Ecomarché on the EN 125 towards Salema is the nearest supermarket, then there is Lagos with more choice again.

Medical facilities

Lagos has its own hospital and the village has a health centre for GP type services.

House prices

An average new two bedroom apartment is around €120,000, and a four bedroom detached villa with pool from

€475,000 upwards.

Recommended hotels or guest houses

The Navigator apartment hotel has a covered pool and overlooks the sea at the Luz end of the beach.

Drive time to Faro airport and directions

The airport is just over one hour's drive, easily accessible via the A22 motorway, then take the second Lagos exit signposted Lagos, Vila do Bispo and Sagres. Follow the link road until meeting the main intersection with the EN 125 at a large roundabout, turn right in the direction of Sagres and pass Luz, Espiche and then turn left for Burgau.

Eating out in Burgau

There are places to suit all tastes and budgets. Here are a few observations based on personal experience and opinions of local residents.

Varandas do Burgau

This café, with a wide terrace overlooking the sea, is a firm favourite. The food is simple, well-presented and perfect for a pleasant lunch. We selected healthy prawn salads at €5.50 which coupled excellence with imagination, whilst we were simultaneously eyeing-up the full English breakfasts (for the same price) being consumed by the people on the adjacent table. It is the laid-back atmosphere that makes this place the perfect location for a leisurely lunch or coffee stop where the music adds to the ambience.

Casa Padaria Pizzaria

Located in the centre of Burgau just opposite the bus stop, it serves the obvious choice of pizzas and pasta as well other snacks. Closed Wednesday.

Ancora

This has a good reputation but is known to be quite expensive.

Beiramar

Again one of the more expensive places to eat.

A Barraca (The Hut)

This popular beach side restaurant, known by locals as The Hut for reasons that are obvious when you see it, specialises in fresh fish and is one of the favourites of the local residents.

Beach Bar

Great views of the sea but quite pricey, it is popular with tourists and residents alike. Open from 12 until 3pm for lunch and 7pm onwards for dinner. There is a path along the beach directly to the restaurant.

Os Amigos

Good reputation for its food but, as it is small, reservations are usually required.

Pielas bar

On one of the two narrow roads leading down to the beach (Luz end of village), it is nice, clean and cosy.

Café Rui and Bar Brizze

Both are good snack bars with good service, clean and friendly.

Nine injured in motorway accident

A minibus carrying scouts from Estômbar and Ferragudo was involved in a violent accident when it seems that a tyre blew out resulting in all nine occupants suffering injuries.

The accident occurred at around 9.10 am on Saturday on the Via do Infante motorway near to Boliqueime travelling eastwards. The group were on their way to a scout camp in Alcoutim to conclude a guide course, which involved various Algarve scout groups. The camp was subsequently cancelled.

Among the injured were six children and three adults, four initially considered to be in critical condition. The emergency services arrived rapidly at the scene and totalled 22 people and eight ambulances from the Bombeiros in Loulé, Albufeira and São Bartolomeu de Messines, two Rapid Emergency Medical Vehicles (VMER) and two INEM ambulances. All were taken to Faro District Hospital and after evaluation two of the victims were transferred to São José Hospital in Lisbon due to the

nature of their injuries. These were a 12 year old girl who had suffered damage to her lower jaw and the driver, a 35 year old woman from Ferragudo who suffered a serious back injury. Four of the other victims were transferred to the Barlavento Hospital in Portimão, nearer to

home and the other three, two children aged 11 and 13 and one adult remained at Faro District Hospital.

The cause of the accident was reported to have been a punctured tyre and the Toyota minibus overturned and was completely destroyed.

Allgarve presentation

The controversial branding exercise is set to become a reality when it will be presented officially here in the Algarve next Saturday at the Lake Resort in Vilamoura.

The presentation of the Algarve events programme in London, due to take place tomorrow was cancelled last Tuesday by minister for the economy, Manuel Pinho, due to the disappearance of Madeleine McCann. Pinho

claimed it was a "sensible decision" at a time when all were concerned about the missing British child.

The presentation was to have been held in a London hotel where a hall was to be trans-

formed into a golf course allegedly using real grass, as well as counting on the presence of José Mourinho and Cristiano Ronaldo. It is estimated that the promotion represented an investment of a few hundred thousand euros.

The Allgarve concept will be presented in Cannes, France this week on May 17.

Date set for RTA elections

Hélder Martins returned to work last week and soon announced that elections for his successor would be held on 5 June. Secretary of State for Tourism, Bernardo Trindade, was informed, as well as the members of the Regional Tourism Commission which has scheduled an extraordinary meeting on 18 May at 3 pm.

Adolescents apprehended in Albufeira

Two 13 year old boys were arrested by the GNR in the early hours of Friday morning. The youths held up two people in the car park of an amusement park using a weapon that was supposedly real and making away with €25, an MP3 player and a mobile phone. A third youth, thought to be about 15, managed to evade arrest. The suspects used a stolen car to make their foiled escape attempt which was later recovered, along with another eight stolen vehicles.

Vilamoura hosts travel conference

The second Annual Congress of the Triton Travel Group took place last weekend at the Tivoli Marinotel, bringing together around 1,000 British travel agents. Event coordinators, the Algarve Tourism Association, apart from general logistics, also arranged a golf tournament for the participants.

Bar fight in youth association

The Fontainhas Youth Sport club bar in Albufeira was the scene of a fight "reminiscent of the Far West," according to the chairman of the association, Amável Domingos. The fight resulted in three arrests and various injuries, including injuries to the hand of an officer of the GNR. The original aggressor was a man who had already created confusion in the club on a previous occasion and the club's directors had pondered the possibility of refusing the person entry. After the youth assaulted the chairman around 10 other people, including women and children, joined in the fray, presumably family and friends of the aggressor. The GNR were called to the scene but were received with beer crates and more violence.

Armed robbery on taxi driver

Last Wednesday the Judicial Police succeeded in arresting two men, 21 and 23 years of age, suspected of armed robbery. A taxi driver had been assaulted by the two men, allegedly Brazilian, the night before, having picked up one of his assailants at the taxi stand in front of Modelo in Albufeira. One man, a passenger, threatened the taxi driver with a gun whilst his accomplice pulled a knife. The incident occurred near Evaristo beach in Galé. The driver gave up €50, apparently all the money he had. Another passing taxi had thought the behaviour of the taxi suspicious and had alerted the authorities.

I asked a company for a quotation to do works and I accepted the quoted price on the document. Now the company is asking for the agreed amount and is adding on the IVA (VAT). Is this legal?

For the company to be able to add the IVA value, it is necessary that the quotation presented to

the customer specified that the IVA (at the current rate) would be added to the price stated. Before accepting any quotation customers should always confirm whether the price given includes the IVA, or not. If there is no specific information included on the quotation with regards to the tax, the customer is not obliged to

pay anything more than the value agreed, being as the customer would presume that IVA is already included.

Do not forget, it is always best to get all terms and conditions in writing before agreeing to a contract in order to avoid future misunderstandings and legal action.

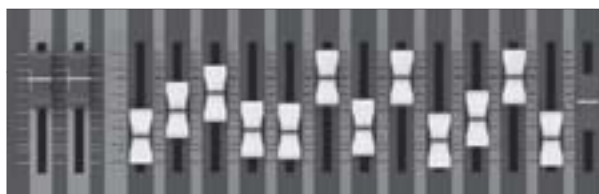

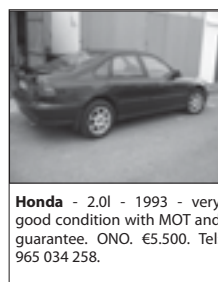

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Big heart, big muscles

Normally, when somebody decides to join a gym they are not in the best of physical fitness. In the gym the most common forms of workout are those that exert the cardio-vascular systems (heart/circulation) and those that concentrate on building muscle. What should one do? Why? For how long? These are some of the questions that arise which we hope to clarify.

When taking the step to exercise regularly, for whatever reason, to lose weight, to lose a belly or excess fat off certain parts of your body or just to breathe more easily, it is necessary to build up stamina in order to sustain a speedier heart rate for a reasonable time.

For beginners cardio training is most important. It is necessary for the body to adapt in order to respond better to the chosen exercise routine. Cardio training will improve the body's resistance to exercise as the heart and lung capacity is improved over time, in turn facilitating the workout as your body adapts. Usually it doesn't take too long for progress to be noticed and after two or three weeks the significant results will be observed and most people notice a tremendous difference in their stamina.

have a device to measure your heart rate while you are exercising. To ensure you are not putting yourself at risk, you should be working between 60 per cent and 80 per cent of your 220 minus age heart rate, i.e. a 40 year old should not exceed a pulse of 144. If you are working a machine with a resistance that doesn't even make you sweat, you will be wasting your time, as your body will not respond or adapt. The time you spend exercising is also very important; for example, cycling for five minutes on a bicycle everyday will not improve your resistance. You should do at least 30 to 40 minutes of cardio-vascular training a day, three or more times a week.

This type of workout is the best exercise if your goal is to lose weight. There is nothing better to metabolise your fat than doing cardio-vascular training to use those extra pounds as energy.

Building brawn

The muscle workout is another type of exercise you can do in a gym. This type of workout is directed more often at specific muscles, usually concentrating on them separately, for example, calves, legs, abdomen, chest, back, shoulders, arms and forearms.

Muscle fitness really helps to define the body in specific areas. For example, ladies, we nearly all have that wobbly bum and triceps issue and, yes, cardio-vascular workouts will certainly help you, but to get far quicker and greater results, focusing on the problem area using weights will definitely give you visual results quite quickly.

We all know how daunting the gym can be, what with all that strange looking apparatus, but in reality, with a little help from an instructor, it is as easy as A-B-C or 1-2-3! As always, it is always advisable to have someone to monitor your performance, ensuring posture and technique are correct.

Adaptations are quickly recognizable, especially in the beginning as you get stronger and more in control of the movements. You can train your muscles everyday as long as you give the muscles you workout 48 hours rest until you work those muscles again. On the inbetween days you work other muscles. For this type of workout it is normal to focus on two muscles a day, a large and a small muscle group, for example, chest and biceps. Remember the weight you use is not as important as technique.

We find lots of young people wanting to carry

more weight instead of getting the technique, and the speed of each movement right, ensuring it isn't too fast! Don't worry about the weight as it is more important to do things slowly and accurately so you can feel your muscles working and better isolate the muscles involved.

Once you have mastered the technique, you can play with the number of exercises, sets, number or repetitions, speed of repetition, time to rest, etc.



• Cardio-vascular apparatus includes treadmills, rowing machines, bicycles, ellipticals (cross-training machines), steppers, or even swimming.

Did you know:

- In order for your body to start burning fat, you need to exercise for over 45 minutes.
- The slower you do your repetitions the more your muscles work.
- The negative part of the exercise should be always slow.
- Don't hold your breath while you exercise your muscles.
- Breath out when you pull or push the weights.
- Breath in during the negative part of exercise.
- Use mirrors to ensure you maintain the correct posture.
- Always use proper clothing while exercising, allowing freedom of movement and transpiration.
- You will quickly recover the water you lose whilst exercising. Losing water doesn't mean you lose weight! Make sure you drink while exercising.
- It is extremely important in order to recover salts and minerals that you lose when sweating.
- Always get someone to help you when using maximum weight.
- If you are not sleeping well probably you are over-training.
- Never smoke or drink alcohol after working out.
- What you eat is as important as working out.
- There are lots of natural supplements to help in achieving your goals.

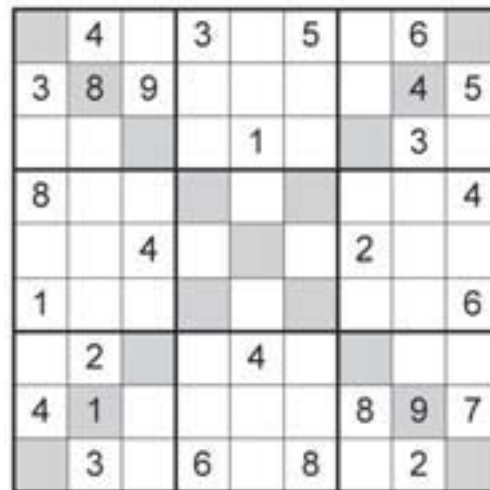

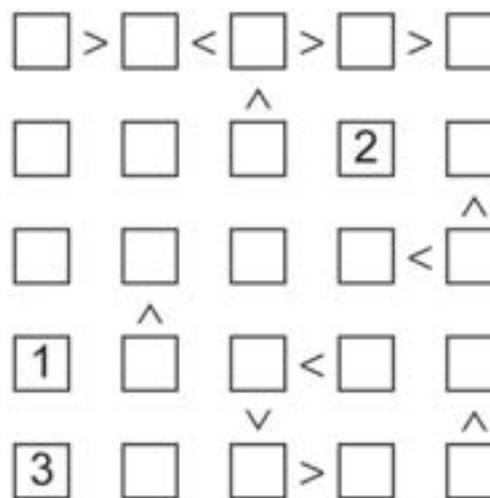

- 15 May**
In 1970 the twin brothers and football players **Frank and Ronald de Boer** were born in the Netherlands. Both played for the Dutch national team as well as many professional clubs in Europe including Al-Rayyan, Ajax, Barcelona and Rangers. Frank represented the *Clockwork Orange* team 112 times and held its captaincy until his retirement after Euro 2004.
- 16 May**
In 1975 Japanese Junko Tabei became the **first woman to reach the summit of Mount Everest**. In 1976, Tabei was the first woman to complete the Seven Summits - the highest mountains of each of the seven continents.

- 17 May**
In 1990 homosexuality was removed from the World Health Organisation's International Classification of Diseases. This day became the **international day against homophobia**.

- 18 May**
In 1974 the Warsaw radio mast, at the time the **tallest construction ever built**, was completed. Building started in July 1970 and it was 646.38 metres tall. It was located in Konstancin, Poland, and was used by Warsaw Radio-Television for longwave radio broadcasting. It later collapsed on 08 August 1991.

- 19 May**
In 1965 female tortoise Tui Malila died. She was the **longest-living animal** according to authenticated records - 188 years old. She was born around 1777 and then given by Captain Cook to the Tongan royal family upon his visit to Tonga, an independent archipelago in the southern Pacific Ocean. She remained in their care until her death.

- 20 May**
In 1916 the small town of Codell, USA, was **struck by a tornado**. Incredibly, the same town was also hit in 1917 and 1918 on the exact same date. Tornadoes have been observed on every continent except Antarctica. However, most of the world's tornadoes occur in the United States.

- 21 May**
In 2004 Russian lieutenant colonel Stanislav Petrov won the World Citizen Award for averting a **potential World War III** in 1983. Assuming his instruments were in error, Petrov deliberately did not report what appeared to be a US attack. The computer reports were later shown to have been in error.

goals to nil in the stadium that had hosted the George Michael concert the evening before. Benfica (64 points) also won their game, 0-1, away to Setúbal.

Spanish Grand Prix

Ferrari's Felipe Massa dominated the Catalunya Grand Prix last weekend winning for the second time in succession with Lewis Hamilton coming second in his fourth race ever in

Formula One, putting him ahead overall in the championship. Spaniard Fernando Alonso came third but nearly crashed on his home circuit when he attempted to overtake Massa around the

outside of the first corner and narrowly missed leaving the track altogether when the two cars touched pitching Alonso sideways into the gravel before he regained control.

PORTUGAL

Baby for Sale

Nine people were arrested last week in Vila Franca de Xira on suspicion of attempting to sell a four month old baby. Apparently the group, which included the child's mother, contacted an allegedly wealthy woman offering the child for sale. The woman refused but was subsequently followed. The police were alerted and the suspects detained only to be released later. The baby was handed over to the local hospital to be delivered to the responsible authorities. The case is under investigation.

GAZA

Violence begins again

Last Sunday four Palestinians died in fighting that has broken out in Gaza following a period of relative quiet. Hamas also claim that 15 of their supporters were abducted in the region. This is the worst fighting since a ceasefire was established in February resulting in a united government.

AFGHANISTAN

Taliban leader killed

Mullah Dadullah the Afghan Taliban commander has been killed in the Helmand province of southern Afghanistan. His death, initially denied by the Taliban insurgents, has been confirmed following official pictures taken by reporters of his body. Dadullah was a fierce fighter, associated with beheadings of foreign hostages and known within the Taliban to be brutal. He lost a leg in 1996 while fighting in Kabul.

IRAQ

More Bloodshed in Baghdad

A suicide bomber in a truck detonated a bomb killing around 45 and wounding more in continuing violence. This time the target was a meeting in the offices of Kurdes, the Kurdistan Democratic Party. Ten people also died in a Shia marketplace over the weekend.

SPAIN

Ex-pats have a voice

San Fulgencio, southern Alicante, is holding local elections with more ex-pats running than Spaniards. The huge concentration of British and Germans in the Costa Blanca and Costa del Sol areas has resulted in a large number running as independent candidates eager to have a say in local politics. Until now many have simply enjoyed the quality of life offered but recent scandals in property ownership, including the so-called Land Grab law in Valencia resulting in many ex-pats losing huge sums of money to developers, has persuaded some to have a voice in the local council. One British man, Tony Cabban, has already been elected as a councilor in Javea, running as an independent to challenge issues around urban planning and other property issues presenting major headaches to foreign and local residents alike.

AUSTRALIA

Cricket boycott

John Howard, prime minister of Australia has decided to withdraw his national cricket team from a scheduled tour of Zimbabwe in September of three one-day internationals. Mr Howard said he does not usually mix sport with politics but this time he had to intervene saying that if the tour took place it would be an "enormous propaganda boost" to Zimbabwe, referring to President Robert Mugabe as a "grubby dictator". In his comments to the press he said: "Whilst it pains me both as a cricket lover and as somebody who genuinely believes these things should be left to sporting organisations, it leaves me with no alternative."

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
